FINANCIAL INFORMATION AND POLICIES
Spring/Summer

- I. **DUES:** Dues can be divided and paid monthly (option 1) or full payment for the complete season (option 2), see registration form for prices. Paying for the complete season is a bit less expensive. Upon completing the registration form, decide which option to use and send in payment before the first practice. If paying monthly, please send in the first two installments, escrow fee, plus the USS fee (USS fee not required if registered in winter 2007-08). An electronic payment voucher will be sent (via e-mail) the 1st week of June for the balance of the season. Please print the voucher and send payment to the KAC office. The address is shown on the registration form. Final and complete payment is due the 15th of the month. Vouchers may also be distributed at practice if you wish. Your child's age as of July 1st 2008 determines their "swimming" age for payment.
- II. **USA SWIMMING FEES:** United States Swimming, the governing body, requires an annual fee for all swimmers, payable each fall. If you have registered and paid this past fall, you do not need to join as your membership is good through the Fall. Summer only or unregistered swimmers pay \$26 for the summer. Kingfish Aquatic Club is a member of USA Swimming. Each registered swimmer will receive a membership card and issues of Splash Magazine as part of being a member. Visit your USA Swimming web site: www.usaswimming.org if you were registered with another USA swim team (at any time previous) you will need to fill out a transfer form to complete your affiliation with KAC. Please see Ed for transfer form.
- III. **ESCROW FEE (for meet entries):** All USS swim meets we attend charge a fee for each event swum (approx \$3-\$4 per event, relays more). One check is required from K.A.C. which will be drawn from the escrow account to pay for your child's entries each meet. Early planning is a must as entries are sent weeks before the actual meet. Please send *in a separate check/ payable to Kingfish Aquatic Club/ \$70.00 for each swimmer*, due with the first payment. Returning swimmers, check with Ed to see your winter balance. (Again please send a separate check for the escrow, as this is kept in a separate account.)
- IV. **MISCELLANEOUS COST:** Other possible costs that each family could incur would be for equipment the swimmer may use. This would include a team suit, goggles, paddles, kickboard, flippers, or swim cap. The only *mandatory equipment will be the KAC team suit, t-shirt (\$15) and cap* (the first team cap is free, \$5/cap after \$10 for Silicon caps). The orange team t-shirt is available from Coach Ed. Kick boards and pull buoys are available for each swimmer to use at the pool. An equipment suggestion list for each age level is posted on the KAC web site. Please put your swimmers name on all their equipment in water proof marker.
- V. **"BRIDGE PROGRAM"/ SUMMER CLUB SWIMMER?** Those who swim with their local summer may want to consider our "Bridge Program". Train with KAC the month of May for stroke instruction and a head start on your fitness, then jump over to your summer club when they start in June. Pay only 1 month fee. Rejoin KAC after your Championships for the local Regional Meet in July if you wish. There is also the option to practice with both your summer club and KAC.
